Works notification

Ballarat East Zone Substation Works update July 2025

Powercor is building a new substation in Ballarat East to enhance the city's energy network and ensure ongoing reliable power access for homes and businesses.

Works

We will be upgrading the existing power network, including works on existing power lines and poles within the current power line easement. As part of this work, some new power poles will be installed, including three in new positions outside the site boundary (see map on the next page).

When

Powerline works will take place on:

- **Wednesday 23 July**
- **Saturday 26 July**
- **Wednesday 6 August**
- **Wednesday 13 August**

All works are subject to weather and site conditions. If we are unable to complete them as planned, they will be rescheduled to the next available shift.

What to expect

- Works to the existing power network will involve replacing some existing poles with new ones and upgrading power lines and related equipment. These works will take place both within the site and along the existing power line easement on Callow Street, between the Canadian Creek Track and Otway Street South.
- There may be minor changes to traffic, parking and access during power line works, with traffic management in place to safely guide residents around work areas as needed.
- Some planned power outages may be needed to complete the power line works. Any affected residents will be notified directly with details about the date, time and duration.
- Some works may generate noise at times.
- Powercor crews and authorised contractors will carry out all works.
