Works notification

Ballarat East Zone Substation Works update August 2025

Powercor is building a new substation in Ballarat East to enhance the city's energy network and ensure ongoing reliable power access for homes and businesses.

Works

We will be carrying out general earthworks and relocating the underground sewer within and adjacent to our site at 203 York Street (see map on the next page).

When

Weekdays between **7am and 5pm**.

Footpath temporary closure

During **August 2025** the footpath between our site at 203 York Street and Pennyweight Gully will be closed temporarily to allow us to complete the sewer relocation works.

Bus stop temporary relocation

The Pennyweight Park/York Street bus stop on Route 20 (towards Canadian) will remain temporarily relocated 20 metres before its original position until the last service on Sunday, 31 August 2025.

What to expect

- General earthworks and sewer relocation works will take place within our site and along the closed footpath area.
- Large machinery, including excavators, trucks and specialised equipment, will be used throughout the works.
- Trucks will be frequently moving in and out of the site during construction hours, primarily via our Callow Street/Larter Street entrance heading towards Main Road.
- Some works may generate noise at times.
- Powercor crews and authorised contractors will carry out all works.
