

Powercor Energy Partner - School Incentive Terms and Conditions

General

1. The promoter is **Powercor Australia Ltd (ACN 064 651 109)** of 40 Market Street, Melbourne 3000 (**Powercor**).
2. Registration and participation in the Powercor Energy Partner Program (the **Program**) is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
3. If there is any inconsistency between these Terms and Conditions, and anything else that refers to this Program, these Terms and Conditions will prevail.

Eligibility

4. Participating schools are deemed to be those schools whose electricity is supplied from either the Waurin Ponds (WPL) or Drysdale (DDL) substations and are listed on the registration page at <https://customermeterdata.portal.powercor.com.au/customermeterdata/CADCampaignPage>.
5. If you register and participate in an "Energy Partner Event" under the Program, and subsequently qualify for, and are paid an incentive under the Program, your vote will automatically be allocated to your chosen school for this incentive (the **Promotion**).
6. Entrants under 18 years of age are not eligible for participation in the Promotion.

How to Enter

7. When registering as an "Energy Partner" under the Program, participants select one school from the drop down box on the registration page.
8. Each selection counts as one vote.
9. A vote will be allocated to the nominated school once participants are fully registered in the program and participate in an Event during the Program period.
10. Any participating school which receives a vote under the Promotion will be eligible to win the prize under the Promotion.

11. The Promotion commences at 12:01am AEST on 14 September 2018 and ends at 11:59pm AEST on 31 March 2019 (**Promotion Period**).

Program Period

Number of Entries Permitted

13. Votes are limited to one per household in the Promotion Period.

Draw and Notification of Winner

14. The winning school will be selected in accordance with these Terms and Conditions and selected by Powercor on Monday 15 April 2019 at 2:00pm AEDT at 40 Market Street, Melbourne, VIC.
15. The participating school with the most votes at the end of the Program Period will be selected as the winner. In the event of a tie, Powercor will draw a winner at the same time and place.
16. Powercor's decision is final and Powercor will not enter into correspondence regarding the competition result or any other decisions Powercor makes in connection with the Promotion.
17. The winner will be notified via phone and email within two days of the draw. The identity of winning school will also be published on Powercor's website at <https://www.powercor.com.au/on> or about Wednesday 17 April 2019.

Unclaimed prizes
