

CitiPower works Collingwood Network Upgrade Project

Energy demand is growing across Collingwood and Fitzroy, so we're working hard to upgrade our network to keep electricity supplies reliable for everyone. We're building more capacity in the local network to support the exciting growth of vibrant education, residential and commercial developments in the neighbourhood

What are we doing?

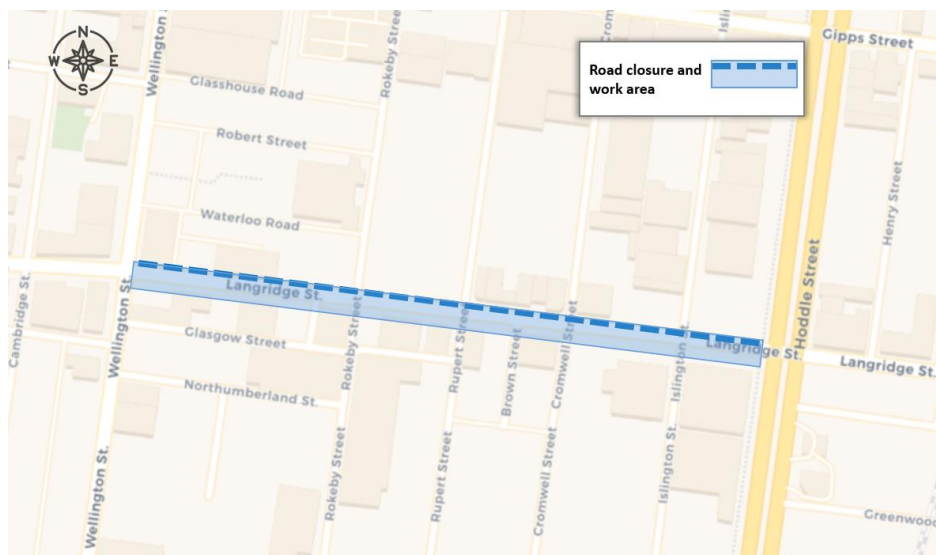
We are installing 1.3 kilometres of new underground cables with the capacity to meet current and future electricity demand in Collingwood and the surrounding area.

When?

Works are scheduled to begin from Wellington Street, heading east down **Langridge Street** from **Tuesday 13 April** until **Wednesday 12 May 2021**. The works will take approximately 4 weeks to complete and will be delivered in stages during our normal working hours between **7am to 4pm, Monday to Friday**.

What can I expect?

- Electricity supply will be maintained, there are no planned outages during these works.
- Road closures on **Langridge Street** will be conducted in short stages to minimise disruption, however local vehicle and pedestrian access will be maintained.
- Traffic controllers will safely direct vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists.
- Some of this work will be noisy from the trenching works.
- The road will be reinstated shortly after trenching works are complete.
