CitiPower works Collingwood Network Upgrade Project

Project update

Energy demand is growing across Collingwood and Fitzroy, so we're working hard to upgrade our network to keep electricity supplies reliable for everyone. We are installing 1.3 kilometres of new underground cables with the capacity to meet current and future electricity demand. We've completed new connections to residential developments in Collingwood and are now moving onto stage two works, connecting the new Australian Catholic University (ACU) site on Victoria Parade. We anticipate the project to be completed by August 2021.

What's happening in my area?


We are organising a second crew to start working at the corner of **Cambridge St** and **Derby St**. The crew will work in 20 metre intervals travelling south down Cambridge St and turning west into Mason St, see map below. The two crews working simultaneously will help fast track the project and minimise long term impacts to the local community.

When?

Works are scheduled to begin on **Tuesday 8 June 2021**, between **7am to 6pm**, **Monday to Friday**. The works along Cambridge St will be completed in 2 weeks and continue west along Mason St.

What can I expect?

- Electricity supply will be maintained, there are no planned outages during these works.
- Temporary lane closures and parking may be disrupted during the works. For more information on parking, please see details on the next page.
- Traffic controllers will safely direct vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists around the work area.
- Local access to residential properties and businesses will be maintained at all times.
- Some of this work will be noisy from the trenching works.
- The road will be reinstated shortly after trenching works are complete.
