



GRANT RECIPIENTS - 2018

ROUND ONE

Club	Grant	Description
Altona Roosters Cricket Club, Altona	\$5,000	The facilities of this small, 100 year old club require rewiring to prevent circuits overloading and electrical trips occurring whenever the kitchen appliances are used. The oven and fridge will also be upgraded.
Boorcan Cricket Club, Boorcan	\$5,000	This family oriented club with 3 teams does not have funds available to support facilities as membership grows. The grant will support new safety switches, external lights and LED flood lights for safety, security and lower operating costs, wiring new power outlets to prevent overloaded circuits and improve electrical safety.
Derrinallum Cricket Club, Ballarat Central	\$5,000	A young and proud club with very old facilities and a need for new electrical wiring, an updated oven and deep fryer.
Point Cook Cricket Club, Point Cook	\$5,000	A number of electrical appliances in the club facilities recently failed safety tests and as a result, were tagged for replacing - bain-marie, electric fry pan, deep fryer and microwave. These are essential for canteen services for this large club of 20 junior and 5 senior teams.
Wendouree Cricket Club, Wendouree	\$2,500	The funding will support electrical works to repair damaged power points and install additional points to replace long extension cables. Aging and second hand appliances that have failed test and tag checks will also be replaced.
West Warrnambool Cricket Club, Warrnambool	\$5,000	The funding will replace and upgrade facilities and appliances currently not functional or creating safety hazards for this large and growing club. This includes a range hood for exhaust fumes, pie warmer, improved kitchen lighting, new smoke detectors and switchboard.
Baden Powell Cricket Club, Frankston	\$5,000	This club is building new facilities but does not have funding for new appliances. The grant will address previous safety concerns but providing new equipment and appliances – microwave, glass washer and pie warmer.
Balmoral Cricket Club, Ascot Vale	\$4,200	A fridge being held together by sticky tape and a freezer with a faulty engine will be replaced through this grant which will also provide a new coffee machine after the existing machine was declared irreparable.

Carnegie South Cricket Club, Carnegie South	\$5,000	The grant will replace an unreliable 20-year old bar fridge which frequently trips the electrical safety switch impacting on all other appliances. This has caused losses of food and drinks in other fridges rendered warm and impacts on fund raising.
Cobram Cricket Club, Cobram	\$5,000	An unreliable oven fixed three times in the past two months will be replaced through this grant as well as a leaking auto-boil tap.
Laharum Cricket Club, Laharum	\$2,500	A 30-year old bain-marie which frequently fails and leaks water is now beyond repair and will be replaced through this grant to support a club which regularly attracts large crowds to its sporting and community events.
Western Cricket Club, Werribee	\$5,000	This club experiences frequent black outs due to too many appliances being connected to too few points. An electrician will repair wiring and the switchboard and also install an oven and stove top.
